The Giving Tree Quilt Workshop

Class Description

Learn to create a festive wall-hanging in just one day! In this fun workshop, you'll make the Giving Tree quilt from Sew Kind of Wonderful's Mini Wonderful Curves book. Learn how to sew gentle curves using the Quick Curve Ruler (QCR) Mini while building a stylized tree complete with a star and trunk. This is a great skill-building project with techniques you'll use again and again.

Skill Level

Confident beginner to intermediate quilters. Basic rotary cutting and piecing skills are helpful; no previous curved sewing experience needed.

What You'll Learn

- How to use the QCR Mini ruler to cut and piece smooth curves
- Tips for accurate curved piecing and pressing
- Adding borders and preparing your quilt top for quilting

Supply List

Required Pattern and Tools

- Mini Wonderful Curves Book by Sew Kind of Wonderful (includes the Giving Tree design)
- Quick Curve Ruler (QCR) Mini

Fabric

- 4 fat quarters (greens) for the tree
- 1 piece 5½" square (yellow/gold) for the star
- 1 piece 5" square (brown) for the trunk
- 1 yard background fabric
- ¼ yard binding fabric (optional if finishing in class)

Basic Sewing Supplies

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Neutral thread
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Pins or clips
- Small scissors and seam ripper

• Iron and pressing mat (or plan to share if provided)

Optional but Helpful

- Stiletto or tool for guiding curved seams
- Travel iron for quick pressing
- Small ruler or trimming tools
