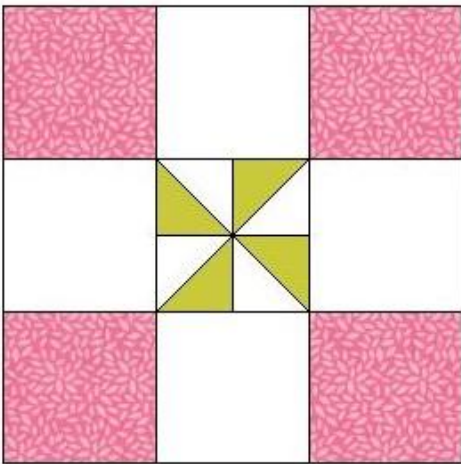


Precision Piecing Class Supply List

In this class you will learn techniques to improve the accuracy of your piecing. We will make the *9-Patch with Pinwheel* block shown below to practice these techniques. We will not be making a quilt top in this class... think of this as making orphan blocks. We will spend a good amount of time working on sewing accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.

Notions Required:

- Sewing machine in good working condition with a new size 80 needle.
- $\frac{1}{4}$ inch piecing foot
- General sewing supplies: scissors, fine patchwork pins, seam ripper, etc.
- Rotary cutter with a new blade, rotary cutting mat, and rotary cutting ruler (minimum 6" x 12")
- Bobbin: wind a bobbin with piecing thread prior to class
- Optional: Bring any tools you use for accurate piecing, block making, and trimming.



Fabric Requirements:

To make one block:

- Fat Eighths or 1/8 yd of each color will work

If using scraps, bring a minimum of:

- 4" X 32" white
- 4" X 20" pink
- 3" X 15" green

Recommend bringing enough fabric to "play" and make more than one block or component.
