



Bee KIND

(Hybrid Hexie Project)

Class instruction will include: how to hand piece hexies using paper pieces, machine piece hexies for background will be demonstrated (no machine is necessary for the ½ day class), fusible applique options, hexie binding, and machine quilting will be demonstrated. Projects are approx.. 24"x24"

Supply List (paper hexies will be provided for class)

1. sewing machine with all its parts, extension cord and power strip (full day class only)
2. iron and pressing pad
3. rotary cutting mat, ruler and cutter
4. fabric and paper scissors
5. pencil and paper for notes
6. thread for basting and for stitching (to match the fabric)
7. needles for basting and for hand stitching
8. binding clips for holding the fabric onto the paper hexies, or glue stick
9. Steam-A-Seam Light II

Fabrics Needed

1. Scraps, charm packs or other pre-cuts will work well for most pieces.
2. Half yard of mini rick rack for antennae
3. Buttons for eyes
4. Background fabrics for hexies 4" x 4" (choose bee theme motifs if possible)
5. 3 yellow and 5 black fabrics for bee body (4" x 8" approximately)
6. Fat eighth or fat quarter of wing fabric
7. Fabric to fussy cut for filling in designs on the wings
8. Black fabric for letters (4" x 4")
9. Red fabric for heart (2" x 2")
10. Backing and Batting 24" x 24"
11. 4 strips 2 ½" x 24" for binding facing on back of quilt
12. 68 squares 2 ½" for the binding hexies on front of quilt

NOTE: if you have extra fabrics to share, this project is great for swapping with friends for more variety. Your bee will be uniquely your own as many variations will be offered, and choice of fabrics can give each bee its own personality.
