

Posh Pouch

This sweet little zipper bag finishes at 6" x 8" and has an easy peasy zipper method that anyone can do! Use any quilting weight cotton for the outside and lining. A lightweight zipper such as YKK or zippers on a roll or a #3 zipper tape are all good choices. At the end of the class, you can make a sweet yo-yo flower to add some signature style to your pouch and make it sassy and posh!

(note: each student must purchase their own copy)

Supplies:

- Basic sewing supplies - straight pins, Wonder Clips, seam ripper, fabric scissors, ruler, rotary cutter, marking pencils, **coordinating threads**, **pre-wound bobbins**, labels to identify pieces.
- Machine needles: 80/12 or 90/14 Microtek Sharps or Denim and/or Top Stitch needles

Tools:

- Sewing machine in good working order, with all parts including power cord and foot pedal, even feed/walking foot and/or standard presser foot. You should be familiar with the use of your machine prior to class.

Bag Section	Amount Needed
Outer Pouch	1 Fat Quarter
Inner Pouch	1 Fat Quarter
Pellon 987FFusible Fleece	¼ Yard
Any Lightweight Interfacing*	¼ Yard
12" to 14" nylon zipper (#3 tape, YKK, Coats & Clark, Zipper on a Roll all work)	
*Some suggested interfacings are Shapeflex SF701 or Pellon 906F or Pellon 911FF	
Bring some fabric scraps and buttons or beads to create your yo-yo flower. You will also need a hand sewing needle.	

Pre-class work:

Please have your bag pieces cut and labeled prior to class. Labels are provided below. We will need all of our time to sew.

If you are comfortable with fusing, please follow the Fusing Instruction in the pattern for the exterior bag side pieces and interior lining pieces. Otherwise, we will do in class.
